

One of its upcoming programmes is Compassionate India.



OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHILDREN

Our Responsibility to Children is a unique positive mental health initiative developed in collaboration with Kerala Police. It was launched in 15 Government schools of Puducherry with the support of the Directorate of School Education, Puducherry. The programme aims to nurture in children, creative and critical thinking. The children are prepared to face any challenges in the fast-changing social and cultural scenarios, to be compassionate to others and to nurture a positive value system.

This programme helped children develop their emotional, behavioural and intellectual capabilities. At the end of the programme, we could notice that children have improved on their communication, leadership and mentoring qualities. This will help achieve their goals in life.

Open Academic Research (OAR) Workshop

The OAR workshop is for a set of young researchers who believe in creative thinking and curiosity-driven minds. This programme was targeted at high school and undergraduate students to help them think critically and independently. The final selection of 12 students was based on the quality and originality of the research problems.







STUDENT-POLICE CADET

The Student-Police Cadet (SPC) Project is a school-based initiative that trains high school students to evolve as future leaders of a democratic society by inculcating within them values, discipline, civic sense, empathy for vulnerable sections of society and resistance to social evils. Sri Aurobindo Society partnered with the Kerala

Police to take this initiative of SPC throughout India.

The SPC Annual Summit 2018, organised at the Special Armed Police Camp, Thiruvananthapuram, was attended by 600 selected SPCs and 200 Community Police Officers.





In the first phase of the Adult Literacy Programme (ALP), women and youth were taught MS Office, Tally and DTP. With the completion of the third batch, training was successfully imparted to 400 villagers.

Scholarship Assistance for economically-backward Children: Children (especially daughters) of widows, destitute and single parents were primarily selected for financial aid. Around 20 students were provided scholarships in 2018–19.



English Access Microscholarship Program

The third batch comprising of 110 aspiring students were trained this year for the English Access Microscholarship Program, sponsored by US Embassy (under the aegis of its Regional English Language Office [RELO]).

Various organizations met at Lake Oussudu on March 22, 2019, for the World Water Day. They were given information about Lake Oussudu, its feeder canals and its biodiversity. They were also explained how Lake Oussudu serves as a major water source for Puducherry. Observations were also made the lack of adequate palm trees and how concrete construction is taking away the natural beauty of the Lake.





PALLIATIVE CARE

Caring for the Old and Terminally ill



AN INTEGRAL APPROACH TO END-OF-LIFE CARE

Palliative care is the care and treatment of the symptoms, discomfort and stress of old age and life-threatening illnesses. In India it is estimated that the total number of people who need palliative care is likely to be 5.4 million people a year, but unfortunately there is neither enough support nor enough facilities.





- Soil management with natural fertilizers and compost.








The Mother

Together they laid the foundation and took up the task of building a new world, a new society that strives to express and embody the new consciousness, which Sri Aurobindo called the 'Supramental'.

Sri Aurobindo

Poet, revolutionary, philosopher, rishi and yogi, Sri Aurobindo was one of the leaders of the freedom movement, who strove for India's complete independence. He came to Pondicherry in 1910 to pursue the Integral Yoga, which aims at a synthesis of Spirit and Matter, at Human Unity in a rich diversity, and a total transformation of this earthly life into Divine life.

Sri Aurobindo Society is named after Sri Aurobindo and draws its inspiration from his vision.
